


PROVIDE DEMONSTRATION




- Show interest in and respect for each participant and others
- 2 Smile and make eye contact with each participant
- 3 Learn and use participants names
- Coach the person rather than just the sport




- Position so all can see and hear
- 2 Provide correct demonstration then focus attention on 1-3 key points
- Provide demonstration more than once from different angles
- Check for understanding before they go for practice



- 1 Plan what to say
- Gain attention before starting
- 3 Keep it simple
- 4 Use questions to check for the players' understanding



- One point at a time: head, hands (Hurley) and feet
- Observe each participant from different angles
- 3 Observe each participant several times
- 4 Check if the activity is working



- Compare your observation with your picture of good practice
- 2 Identify the matching key points
- Identify the mismatching key points
- Oecide whether to reinforce, modify or note but take no immediate action



- Ask 'what did you notice about...' to promote self-analysis
- 2 Limit information to 1-3 key points
- Give specific, simple information in a positive way
- Check for understanding: 'what will you now do?'
